BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue UFSD hereby approves the attached resolution to participate in the ESBOCES Joint Municipal Cooperative Bidding Program as submitted by ESBOCES and authorizes the Board of Education President to sign said resolution as required by ESBOCES.

- c. Legal Counsel Retainer 2022-2023
BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue Union Free School District hereby approves the Agreement for General and Labor Counsel Services between the Quogue UFSD and the Volz & Vigliotta, PLLC, in the amount of \$27,000 for the 2022-2023 school year and authorizes the President of the Board of Education to sign the agreement.

- d. Consulting Services Agreement – Claims Auditor
BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue Union Free School District hereby approves the Consulting Services Agreement between the Quogue UFSD and Frank Perry for the 2022-2023 school year at hourly rate of \$120 as per the Consulting Services Agreement and authorizes the President of the Board of Education to sign the Consulting Services Agreement.

- e. Complete Rehabilitation PT, OT, SLP of the Hamptons - Service Contract
BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue Union Free School District hereby approves the Special Education Services Contract between the Quogue UFSD and Complete Rehabilitation PT, OT, SLP of the Hamptons, for the 2022-2023 school year and authorizes the President of the Board of Education to sign the contract.

11. Facilities

a. Fuel Oil Bid

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue Union Free School District hereby awards the fuel oil bid to Quogue-Sinclair, the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$0.22 above the Northville Industries tank car reseller price for the 2022-2023 school year.

b. Landscape Bid

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue Union Free School District hereby awards the landscaping bid to Steve’s Landscaping LLC, the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$18,950 for the 2022-2023 school year.

12. Personnel Matters

a. Maternity Leave

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue UFSD hereby approves Ms. Laura Meyer’s request for maternity leave beginning on September 1, 2022 and ending on January 2, 2023, in accordance with Paragraph 4(c) of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Quogue UFSD Board of Education and the Quogue Teachers’ Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Quogue UFSD hereby approves Ms. Laura Meyer’s request to use 19 of her accumulated sick days due to physical disability pending receipt of a doctor’s note.

b. Impartial Hearing Officers

WHEREAS, the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, Pursuant to Sections 207, 3214, 4403, 4404 and 4410 of the Education Law, Part 200, amended October 2016, Section 200.2(e) states, “the Board of Education or trustees of each school district shall establish a list of: ... the name and statement of the qualifications of each impartial hearing officer who is: (i) certified by the Commissioner of Education pursuant to section 200.1(x)(2) of this Part and; (ii) available to serve in the district in hearings conducted pursuant to Education Law section 4404(1). Appointment of impartial hearing officers pursuant to Education Law section 4404(1) shall be made only from such list and in accordance with the rotation selection process prescribed herein and the timelines and procedures in section 200.5(j) of this Part. Such names will be listed in alphabetical order. Selection from such list shall be made on a rotational basis beginning with the first name

appearing after the impartial hearing officer who last served or, in the event no impartial hearing officer on the list has served, beginning with the first name appearing on such list. Should that impartial hearing officer decline appointment, or if, within 24 hours, the impartial hearing officer fails to respond or is unreachable after reasonable efforts by the district that are documented and can be independently verified, each successive impartial hearing officer whose name next appears on the list, shall be offered appointment, until such appointment is accepted. The name of any newly certified impartial hearing officer who is available to serve in the district shall be inserted into the list in alphabetical order (list included in supplemental file).”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Quogue UFSD hereby adopts the roster of eligible hearing officers identified by the New York State Education Department, as may be modified by the Commissioner of Education.

c. Authorization of Superintendent to Temporarily Appoint Personnel

WHEREAS, the Quogue Union Free School District may need to fill vacancies during the 2022-2023 school year due to reasons such as resignations, leaves of absence, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Quogue Union Free School District meets regularly on the second Tuesday of each month; and

WHEREAS, the Quogue Union Free School District wishes to authorize the Superintendent of Schools to temporarily fill such positions prior to the District’s next scheduled board meeting,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Quogue Union Free School District hereby authorizes the Superintendent to temporarily appoint personnel to fill such vacancies prior to the next scheduled board meeting throughout the 2022-2023 school year.

14. Open Time

The purpose of “Open Time” is to permit any person in attendance to address the Board of Education regarding any matter concerning the school district.

15. Executive Session

Recess to Executive session for discussion involving the medical, financial, credit or employment history of a particular person or corporation or matters leading to the appointment, employment, promotion, demotion, discipline, suspension, dismissal or removal of a particular person or corporation; and, the proposed acquisition, sale, or lease of real property or the proposed acquisition, sale or exchange of securities, but only when publicity would substantially affect the value of these things.
